Our interdisciplinary team includes other nurse practitioners, family physicians, registered nurses, medical receptionists diabetes educators, social workers, community support workers, and other health care professionals.

Nurse Practitioner, RN (Extended Class) - Primary Care - (0.6FTE) 3 days/week

The Nurse Practitioner, RN (EC) provides primary health care services with strong emphasis on disease prevention, health promotion and chronic disease management. The position will manage a primary care practice of approximately 475 clients across the lifespan within a cohesive provider team of other nurse practitioners and family physicians. This position will also be scheduled for some same day access clinics, and may be cross-trained to provide coverage to different clinics geared towards serving the Centre's priority populations.

- Minimum two years experience as a Nurse Practitioner, RN (EC) in a community primary care setting, including working with clients throughout the life cycle and across the wellness-to-illness continuum.
- Bachelor degree in Nursing
- Registration in the Extended Class with the College of Nurses of Ontario.
- Current professional liability coverage
- Knowledge of and commitment to community-based health care
- Significant expertise in supporting people with complex mental health and addiction issues
- Demonstrated ability to apply a harm reduction approach to care
- Knowledge of and ability to work effectively with diverse populations applying a health equity, anti-racism and anti-oppression lens.
- Ability to work effectively, independently and in a multi-disciplinary team setting
- Strong clinical assessment skills
- Strong problem solving skills
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Excellent interpersonal and organizational skills

- Available to work occasional scheduled evenings or weekends.
