Working within our interdisciplinary team, the Nurse Practitioner provides high quality, full scope professional care to patients, including provision of primary care and participation in the development, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of the FHT's programs and services. The NP will have the opportunity to attach patients and work within a 'Most Responsible Provider' model of care as part of their role.

The Ancient Rivers Family Health Team (FHT) is a group of interprofessional healthcare providers associated with the Ancient Rivers Family Health Organization (FHO), a group of 17 family doctors in Renfrew and Calabogie with a combined roster of 13 000 patients on 1 shared EMR (Telus Practice Solutions).

Main Responsibilities

- Provide comprehensive, evidence-based care in alignment with the College of Nurses of Ontario (CNO) Practice Standards and the competencies outlined by the Canadian Nurses Association. This includes the authority to diagnose, order and interpret diagnostic tests, prescribe medications, and perform medical procedures.
- Demonstrate advanced clinical judgment and a high level of autonomy in managing acute and chronic conditions, as well as promoting health and wellness.
- Attach and provide care for a roster of patients as the Most Responsible Provider, ensuring continuity and quality of care.
- Support the care of physician-rostered patients as part of the collaborative clinical team.
- Design and deliver care programs for unattached patients, such as post-emergency department discharge follow-up, urgent care clinics, and cancer screening clinics.
- Lead and participate in health promotion and disease prevention initiatives to support overall community wellness.
- Effectively utilize the electronic medical records (EMR) system for documentation, assessment, care planning, and communication within the care team.
